Yearbook orders may also be purchased through Infinite Campus or the bookstore. Please note that there is a fee of approximately \$2 for all transactions through Infinite Campus – there is no fee for orders placed through the yearbook order center.

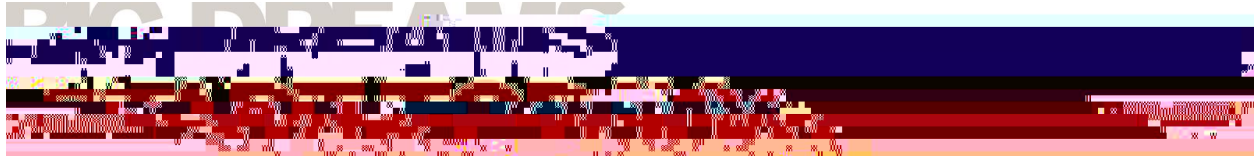

***Yearbook orders** are placed to the plant after January 10. Books are not guaranteed after that date. After March 1, books can only be purchased in the bookstore. We sold out in previous years, so pre-ordering is encouraged.

Seniors: Senior portraits taken at the Lou Coopey Studio are the photos included in the yearbook for seniors– ID photos for seniors, taken on campus, are NOT included in the yearbook. It is important that seniors have their portraits taken at the Lou Coopey Studio (book your appointment online at Loucoopey.com) in Mesa prior to October 1st for inclusion in the yearbook as these pages are submitted for printing during our December yearbook deadline. Please note that there will be head-shot photos only taken on campus November 10th if you are unable to book the studio appointment.

Juniors, Sophomores & Freshmen: Photos taken by the Lou Coopey studio for the yearbook, student IDs, and for purchase will be on 8/17 & 8/18, and scheduled through students' English classes. English teachers will notify students which day their class is scheduled, and distribute packets for ordering prints prior to picture day. Retakes will be 9/29 during 4th & 5th hours. Note: Students who miss all three days are unable to be included in the yearbook.
